Academic Advisory Committees of NSFC Scientific Departments

he academic advisory committees of NSFC scientific departments were established in 2002 to better the expert advisory system for NSFC's management and ensure that the funding decision-making and management are conducted by NSFC scientific departments in a scientific way. The committees are responsible for advising on the formulation of the priority funding areas, funding schemes, major research plans, annual funding arrangements, disciplinary development strategies, and the constitution of review panels for the scientific departments. Director Generals of NSFC scientific departments assume the position of chairmen of the academic advisory committees, with the tenure system being adopted. Presently, there are a total of 152 scientists serving on the respective NSFC academic advisory committees.
